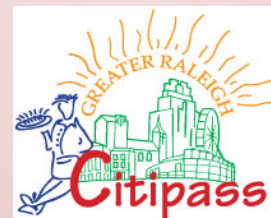

NCSU Home Football Games



We have an exciting fund raising opportunity to work with Staff One Services at NCSU home football games as ticket takers and ushers. Brief highlights of the program are listed below and the rest of the details are in the linked document [FundraiserNCSU Football 2009.doc](#). Please read it in entirety, most questions can be answered from it. To sign up just fill in the information below and it will be sent to Ray Winter, the coordinator, and he will sign you up and display those signed up for each game on the band calendar link for that game. Hope you can participate.

- Staff One Services is the company that supplies full time staff and volunteers for NCSU home football games as ticket takers, and ushers. No training is necessary for ticket takers and ushers.
- Ticket takers age 16 (17 last year) and up, and ushers are age 18 and up.
- Ushers and Ticket takers get \$8.00. We are paid from the time you sign in until you sign out. Gates open 2 hours before game time and volunteers need to arrive 2.5 hours before game time. Go to Gate 7 on the east side of the stadium the side facing Blue Ridge Rd and sign in. You are paid from the time you check in so find the sign in sheet right away.
- Free parking by the horse complex gate H8 off Trinity road.
- By the 5th of the each month, Ray Winter sends our volunteer names to Staff One Services for each game that month. New for this year volunteers are capped for each game. The staff coordinator is trying to get somewhat consistent number of volunteers from each group for each game. Sign up as early and to all games you plan on attending so we can attend more games. If we only have one or two volunteers for a game we may not be able to attend that game. We have a great track record so the new rules may be bent for us. I know the later games still don't have kickoff times, but if you know you can probable attend a Saturday game without a time sign up and reevaluate when the time is announced.

What is SCRIP? FUNDRAISING WHILE YOU SHOP!

SCRIP: The concept of SCRIP is that the band purchases gift card certificates, or SCRIP, at a discount from a company that provides gift cards to popular retailers (like Blockbuster, Chili's, and Home Depot). Band families order the gift certificates at face value. The gift card (scrip) is then spent at the retailer, where it's worth the full face value. No extra money has been spent and your Fair Share just made a profit. The difference between the discount and the face value goes directly into your student's Fair Share account. Hundreds of retailers are available. It will be an ongoing opportunity.

SCRIP orders can be placed online at <http://www.shopwithscrip.com/>. The following information is needed to set up a scrip online account: Organization: Sanderson Band Boosters, Raleigh, NC. Enrollment Code: E714FF3412769.

Once you've placed your online order, a receipt for the order must be printed out and mailed with your check payable to Sanderson Band Boosters to Julie Lebria at the address below. Checks should be received by Julie by the 15th of each month.
