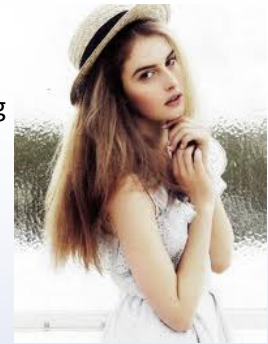

I have been very involved with percussion since I heard Julie Oliver talk about how exciting band could be when I was in the 5th grade. I have participated with All County, All District, NC All State Percussion Ensemble, Sanderson Bands and Percussion Ensemble, marched in the 2006 Macy's All American Marching Band, was a member of the indoor drumline WGI worldclass "Constitution", Appalachian's marching band and ASU bands and orchestra (I got to travel to China with the orchestra!) and I have attended many summer percussion camps such as Oberlin School of Music Summer Percussion Institute, Matt Savage Marching Percussion, University of Georgia at Athens Summer Marching Drumline and NCSA Summer Percussion Institute.
