Marching Bio:

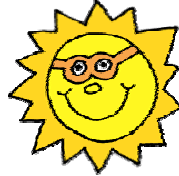
This upcoming season will be my 3rd year marching Carolina Crown as a lead trumpet.

Booster Recipe Request

Bacon Wrapped Smokies – This is a party favorite at our Band Booster parties for those who have asked Jean for the recipe.

- 1 pound sliced bacon, cut into thirds
- 1 (14 ounce) package beef cocktail wieners/lil smokies
- 3/4 cup brown sugar, or to taste (I use more)

Directions

1. Preheat the oven to 325 degrees F.
2. Wrap each cocktail wiener with a piece of bacon and secure with a toothpick.
3. Place brown sugar in large baggy. Add 10 or so wieners at a time and toss to coat. Place wieners on foil lined baking sheet.
4. Bake for 40 minutes in the preheated oven or until the sugar is bubbly and bacon is crisp. To serve, place the wieners in a slow cooker and keep on the low setting. HA – I never have to use a crockpot cause they never seem to last very long!!
 - I also serve with sauce:
 - 1/4 cup mayonnaise
 - 1/4 cup barbeque sauce
 - 2 tablespoons brown sugar

The piece we are preparing this season is *Katraerra* by Jim Casella. *Katraterra* is a 5 minute work for 9 percussionists and uses a variety of contrasting timbres throughout. Contrasting percussion voices are used to make bold, aggressive statements and answers with tom toms, timpani, different sized cowbells, woodblocks, China cymbal and Chinese opera gong (to name a few). The main melodic theme is carried by the vibraphone, and driven by the timpani and marimba accompaniment. This melodic theme becomes almost improvisatory when the marimba player adds to it in harmonized, syncopated style. In almost all cases, each performer is required to play multiple instruments with a variety of timbral approaches. The end result is an intense, driving work for percussion ensemble that will draw listeners into a cyclical feel of syncopated groove.

We will be performing in three Atlantic Indoor Association (AIA) competitions and at the Sanderson band concert.

Competition dates are:

- February 19th at Cary HS
- February 26th at Clayton HS
- March 19th at Wakefield HS.

We look forward to another winning season!
